We are currently working on addition and subtraction with double-digit numbers. We use multiple strategies to solve these equations, but the most common mistake I see is with their simple math facts. It is very important for children to be accurate and fluent with their math facts. Please consider practicing these at home more often. As I mentioned before, xtramath.org is one way for them to master these skills.

Right now, we are focusing also on being kind to everyone. I am asking kids to **THINK** before they speak or act. Ask yourself, **T**: is it true? **H**: is it helpful? **I**: is it important? **N**: is it necessary? **K**: is it kind? I am hoping that by discussing this with the kids, they will start to think about how they are treating each other and we will avoid hurt feelings and conflict.
